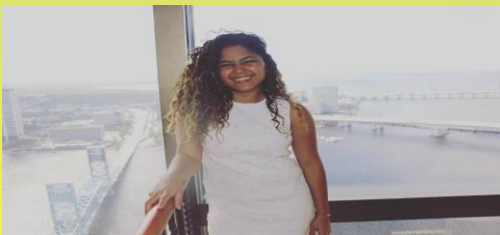
DEAR GUARDIANS AND SCHOLARS,
