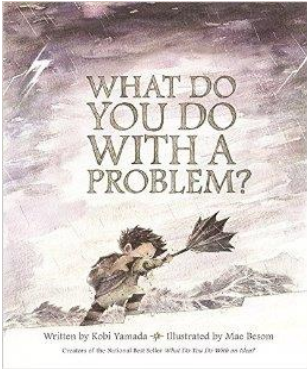

Reading:

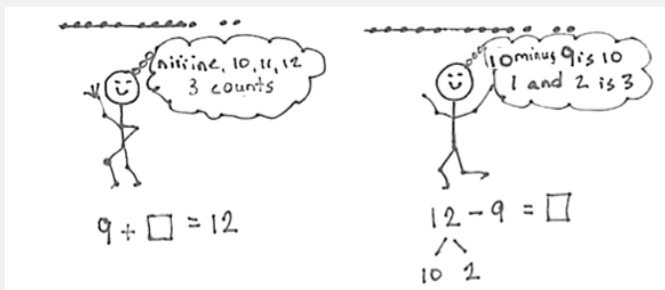
Scholars will use text features to learn about a topic and locate key information in a text.
