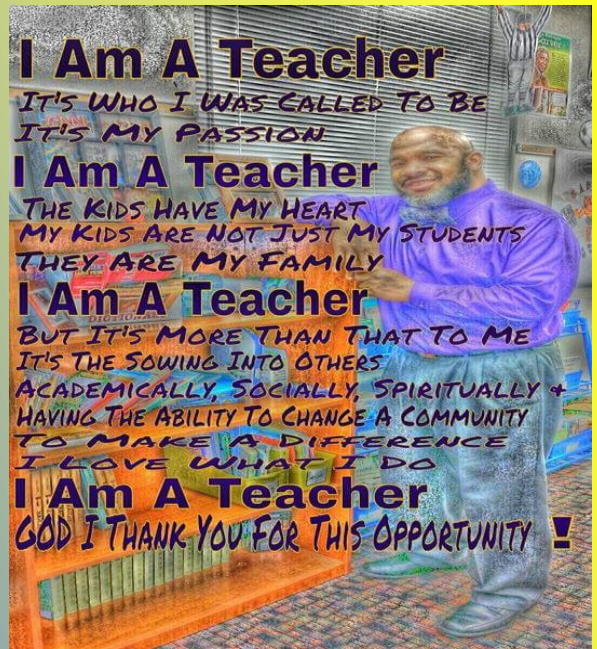
Academic Success Corner
