Student Assessments/Progress Monitoring

We conduct progress monitoring on a frequent and regular basis. In August every child at Tiger Academy took baseline assessments using our I-Ready Diagnostic program. Teachers also assessed reading abilities using a Diagnostic Reading Assessment (DRA) protocol. Our diagnostics and DRA assessments are administered 3 times a year in the fall, winter, and spring. We also administer a writing assessment in grades 3-5 three times per year using Write Score.

We are currently administering our midyear progress monitoring assessments. The data will be analyzed during grade level meetings. This data will be shared with the curriculum committee in early February.

Saturday School began January 9th. All students are able to attend Saturday school but students who fall within the bottom quartile on their assessment data are highly encouraged to attend.

Virtual Learning Letters

In compliance with DOE Order No. 2020-EO-07, all families who choose to keep their students at home and learn virtually this quarter **and** are not making adequate progress **and/or** are truant or frequently absent, received a letter from the school.



These letters provide written notice to the parent or guardian that the child is not making adequate progress and other associated education risks. Families must submit written acknowledgement verifying the receipt of the information and the intent to remain in an online learning modality.

We currently have 33 students receiving virtual instruction. Kindergarten – 3 1^{st} Grade – 3 2^{nd} Grade – 7

3rd Grade – 7 4th Grade – 2

5th Grade – 11
