## What are we learning?

**Phonics:** (M-T) Open Syllables (W-Th) Closed/Closed Syllables

**Math:** We have entered a new unit in math as well. This week we will begin to learn more about the meaning of subtraction through word problems. 8-1 through 8-5 is what's been assigned for this week as homework.
