What are we learning?

Phonics: (M-T) This week we are learning about the final stable syllable /le/ (W-Th) We are also learning that y spells /e/ at the end of longer words that have more than one syllable.

Reading: This week we are continuing to learn about technology with a focus on the central idea, relevant details, and understanding the text better using the main story elements - characters, setting, plot.

Math: We have our UNIT 10 test this Tuesday and we will begin unit 11 on Wednesday. Unit 11 is all about subtracting within 100!! (please be practicing math facts with your scholar!!)

Science: This week we are diving into learning more about living things and how some living things look like their parents. **If you have any photos of you and your scholar this would be the best time to send them in as we will be able to observe how animals look like their parents.**
