Arrives – reach a place at the end of a journey

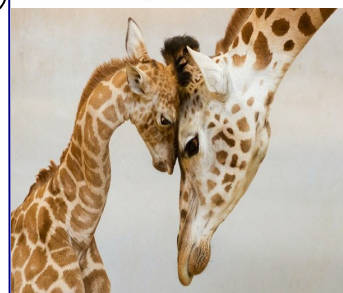
