Wiggle - moving up and down or from side to side

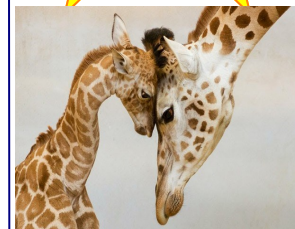
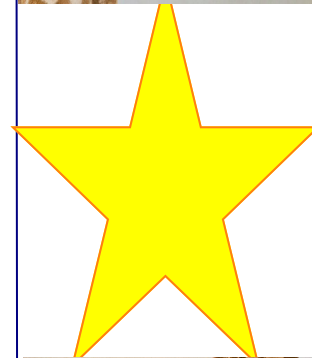
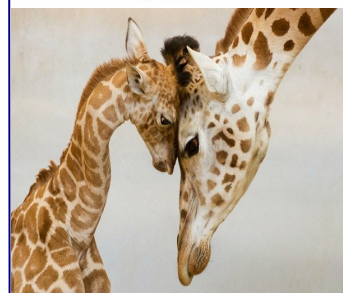
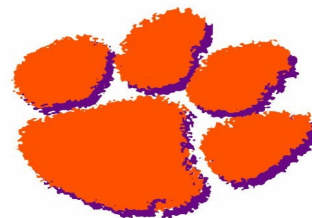
