Ripe—ready for harvesting or eating

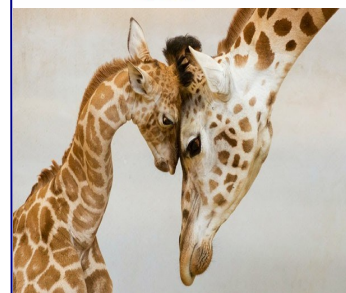

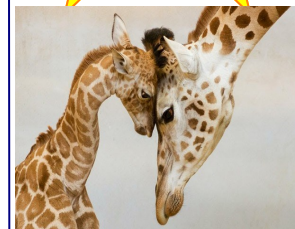
