**cheer**— to give hope, make happy sounds

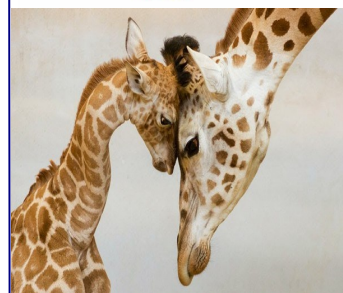

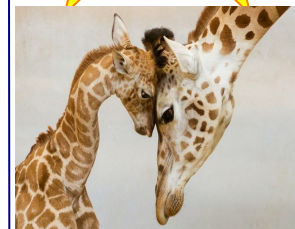
