**Member**—people belonging to the same group

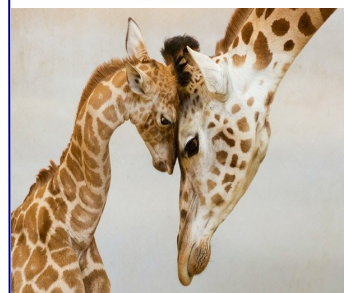

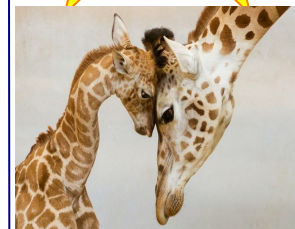
