**gown**— a long dress, typically with a close fitting bodice and a flared bottom

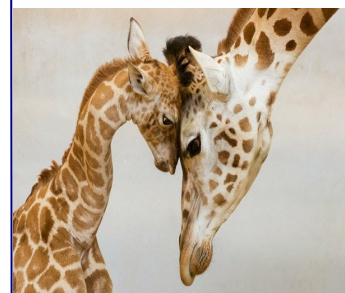
**cartwheel** — a circular sideways hand-spring with the arms and legs extended

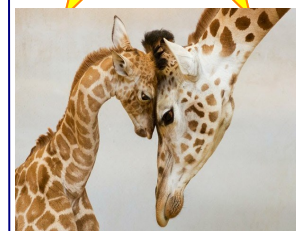
