chimpanzee—a great ape with large apes

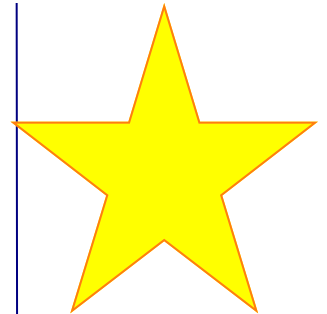
wolves—the largest members of the dog family
