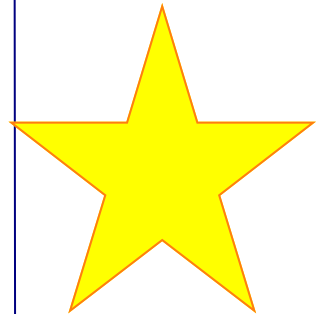
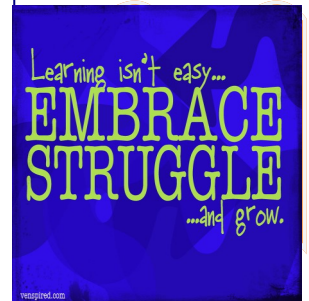
Crawls—move forward on hands and knees by dragging the body close to the ground
