Science: Recognize animals are living things that need food, water, air & shelter to live.

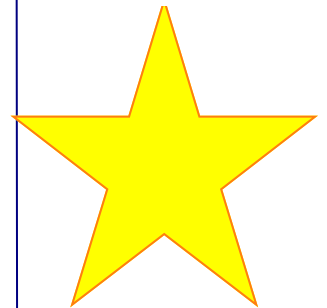
